Install on carpet to prevent scratches.



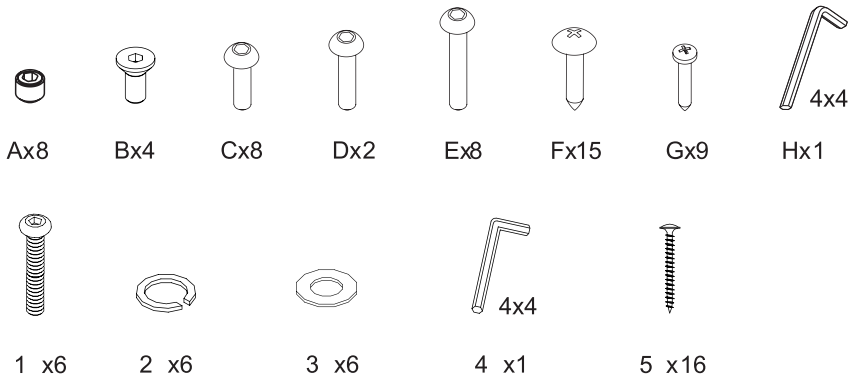
Bring your own phillips screwdriver or pistol drill.

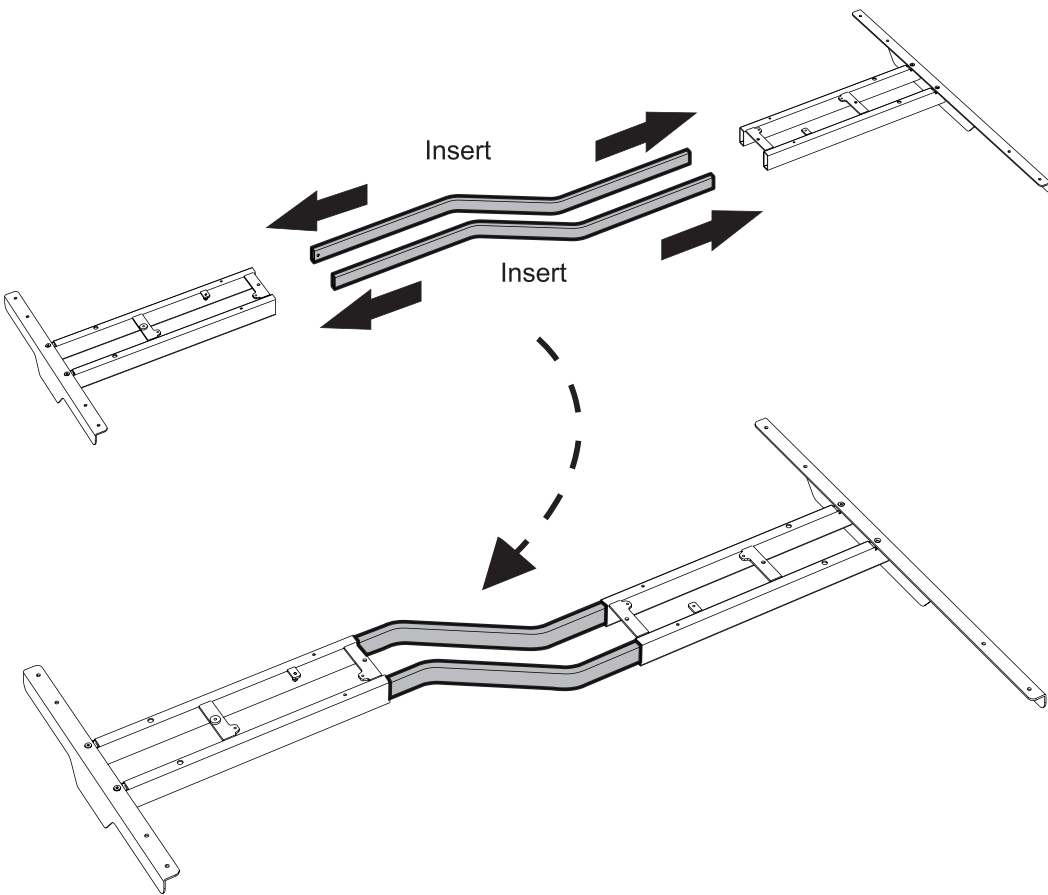
01 Attach the side brackets to the beam



⚠ When installing the beam, loosely insert all screws first. Once all screws are in place, tighten them evenly.

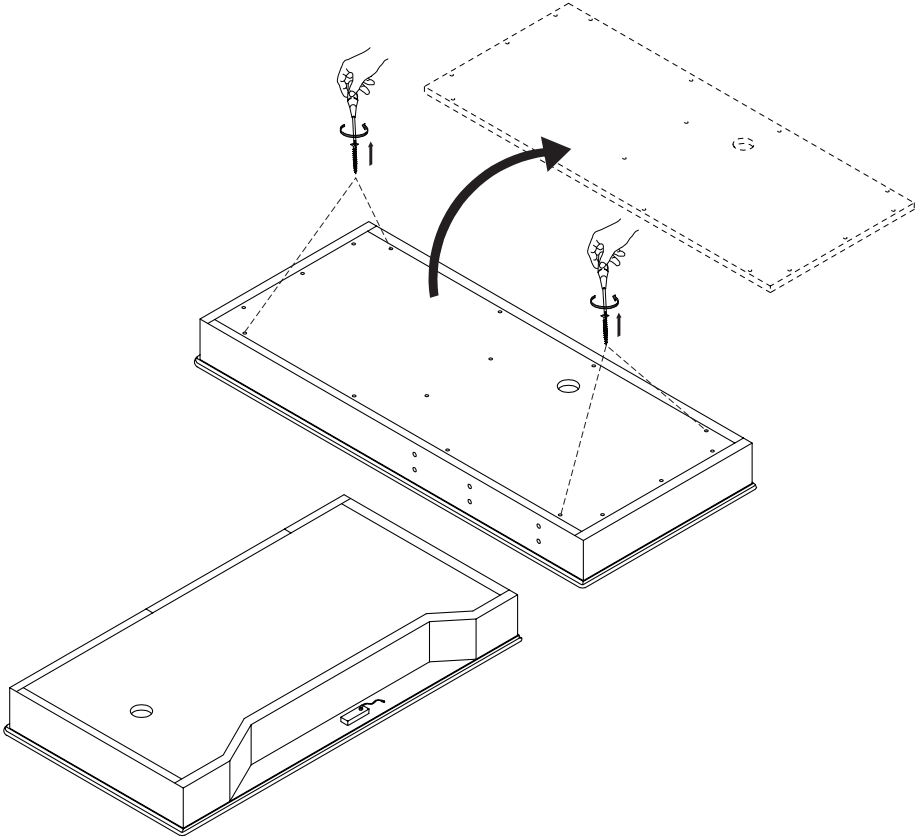
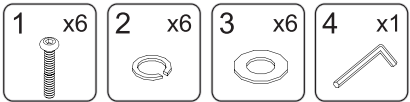

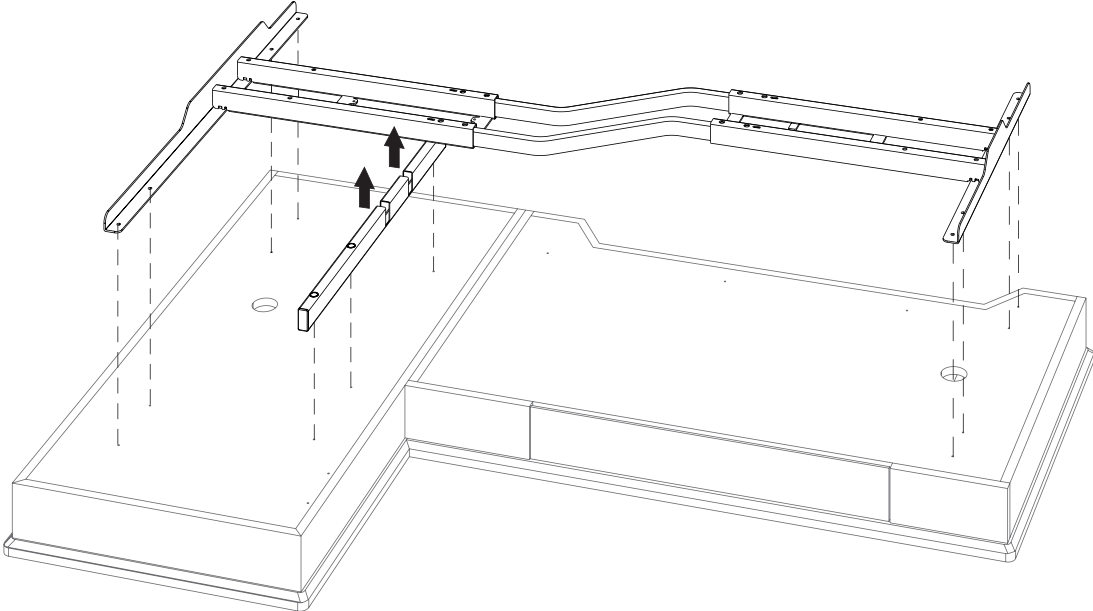

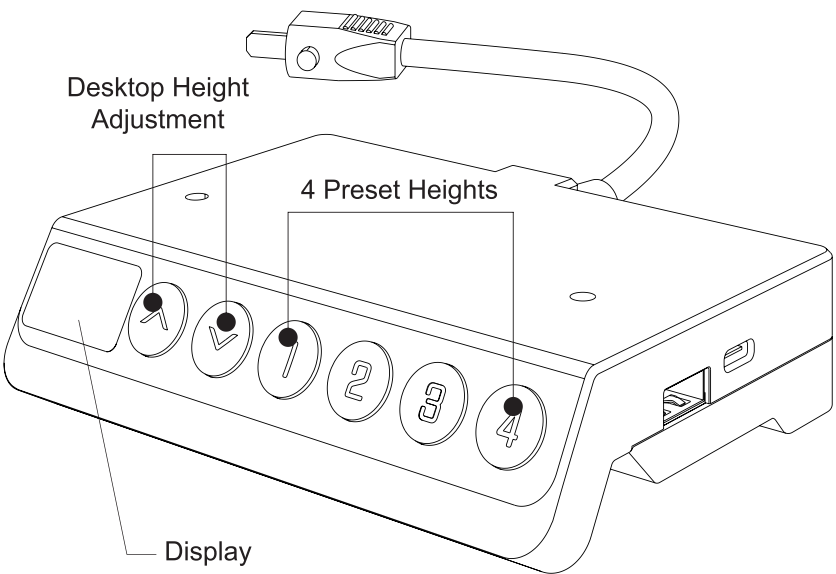


The velcro strap is 78.7 inches (2 meters) long and reusable. You can cut it to the desired length as needed to organize and secure your cables.

Note: Ensure there are no obstacles during desk height adjustment, and make sure all cables are long enough to allow full movement.

Tip: Program your preferred sitting height to preset "1" and your preferred standing height to preset "2". The remaining presets can be customized as needed.

• Fast Charging

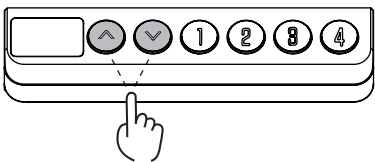
Safety: Built-in over-temperature, over-current, and short-circuit protection. Output ports have current-limiting protection to ensure the product operates within safe current ranges.

Compatibility: Compatible with most mainstream smartphones and laptops, providing fast charging for your devices.

• Output Specifications

1. Single USB Type-C port output: 5V/3A, 9V/3A, 12V/3A, 15V/3A, 20V/2.25A, 3.6V–20V / MAX 45W
2. Single USB Type-A port output: 5V/3A, 9V/3A, 12V/3A, 15V/3A, 20V/2.25A, 3.6V–20V / MAX 45W
3. Simultaneous Type-C and Type-A output: 5V / MAX 20W
4. Note: The charging function is disabled while the desk is moving. Charging resumes normally when the desk stops.

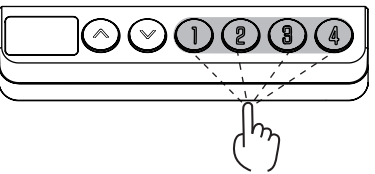
• Height Adjustment



Press the "↑" or "↓" button to rise or lower the desk. The current height will be displayed on the screen.

• Preset Height

a. When the desktop is stationary, press and hold button "1" for 3 seconds. When the display shows "5-1", the current height is successfully saved.

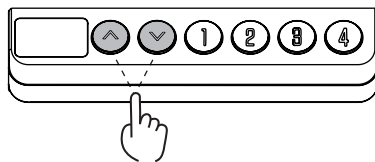


b. Buttons "2", "3", and "4" have the same memory function as button "1". Repeat the above steps to save the current height to the corresponding button. The display will show "5-2", "5-3", or "5-4" accordingly.

c. At any desk height, pressing button "1", "2", "3", or "4" will automatically adjust the desk to the previously saved position.

• Anti-Collision Sensitivity Adjustment

a. There are 4 sensitivity levels. When the lifting system encounters an obstacle, this function triggers a reverse protection.

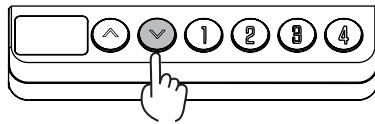


b. Press and hold the "↑" and "↓" buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds to switch the sensitivity. Each operation switches one level, with a total of 4 levels: "A-0", "A-1", "A-2", "A-3".

c. Display indications:
"A-0", Anti-collision function off;
"A-1", Low sensitivity;
"A-2", Medium sensitivity;
"A-3", High sensitivity.

• Reset

a. Reset function: when the LED display shows "H5L" or "r5L", press and hold the down button until the desk reaches its lowest position and then rebounds slightly to stop. The display will show the minimum height. Release the down button "↓" to complete the reset. The desk can then be used normally.



b. If "E01" or "E02" appears, allow the desk to rest for at least 18 minutes before using it again.

c. If other codes appear and holding the "↓" button has no response, check that all cables are undamaged and properly connected. Disconnect the power for at least 10 seconds, then reconnect. When the display shows "H5L" or "r5L", press and hold the "↓" button to reset.

d. If the desk still does not operate normally after performing the above steps, please contact customer service.

• 24V DC Power Output

1. When the desk is in motion, the 2-pin connector at the back of the control box does not output 24V DC.
2. When the desk has been stationary for 1 second, the 2-pin connector at the back of the control box outputs 24V DC.

Resolving Common Issues

The following tips will help you identify and correct common issues. If you encounter an issue not listed in the table below, or if you follow the instructions below and the issue is still not resolved, please contact your supplier. All such anomalies or errors can only be investigated and corrected by the manufacturer or specially trained personnel.

Problem	Solution
Electronic functions do not function properly	Checking that the connection cables are properly connected.
Speed of lifting is slow	Check if the load weighs more than 242 lbs
Worksurface downward sliding	
Automatically reset a lot	
Can lift but cannot lower down	Start the reset process.
Insufficient ascent and descent height	
Bottom cannot rise	
Overworked beyond duty cycle: Max 2 min on/18 min off	Keep the power on and stop working for 18 minutes.
Power supply module not working	Need to reset first or wait 1s after rise and fall after use.
Press the down button to raise the device instead of lowering it	Check for obstructions under the table or dangling wire harnesses.

Attention

- Power supply: AC100V - 240V, frequency 50/60HZ;
- Working environment: 32°-104°F;
- Before cleaning, you have to unplug the power supply cable. Clean with a slightly damp cloth to wipe away the surface dust. Keep all electrical components away from liquids. Do not damage the connection line and keep the plug in a safe position.
- Inside the control box, there are electronic components, metal parts, plastic parts, wires and so on. They should be disposed in accordance with the local laws and regulations. They cannot be disposed as household waste.
- Before using the product, please make sure the product has been installed correctly.

10 years: all metal and mechanical parts and components, including motors and electrical components of FlexiSpot Standing Desk E5 series.

5 years: all metal and mechanical parts and components, including motors and electrical components of all other height adjustable desk except for E5, E7 series.

·FlexiSpot Sit-Stand Desktop Workstations

All standing desks purchased on or after October 5, 2016 include a 5-year warranty for the frame, medium-fiber desktop and mechanisms.

·FlexiSpot Desk Bikes

All desk bikes purchased on or after October 5, 2016 include a 3-year warranty for the frame, and a 1-year warranty for the electronics and other mechanisms.

·FlexiSpot Mini Steppers

All desk bikes purchased on or after October 5, 2016 include a 1-year warranty for the frame, and other mechanisms.

·Accessories

All monitor mounts purchased on or after October 5, 2016 include a 5-year warranty for the arms, 3-year warranty for gas spring system and mechanisms.

What are your Remedies?

FlexiSpot will replace at no charge to the consumer the defective parts only or, at FlexiSpot's option, replace any product or part of the product that is defective because of improper workmanship and/or material, under normal installation, use, service and maintenance.
